  - The Parish council submitted a letter of objection following the last parish council meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> February 2023.
  - It is understood that the application was to go to consultation on 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023 this has been withdrawn by the developer.
- **4.2** An appeal for application under **22/01486/OUT** has been made by the developer under 23/0005/REFUSE. A letter from the parish council has been tabled in a similar style and response to the letter of objection for the application made under **23/00243/OUT** and will be emailed to West3@planinginspectorate.gov.uk (emailed by PC on 28 March 2023)
- **4.3** New build detached 3 bedroom dwelling with garden and parking **23/00574/FUL.** This development was discussed and the issues arising were;
  - Soakaways and the impact of rain water
