3. Matters arising

- 3.1** Speeding update – further research surrounding the ability to install a speeding matrix sign. It may be possible to obtain funding from 'North Yorkshire, Police, Fire and Crime Commissioner – community fund grant'. The Parish Council need to establish the order into which to undertake the necessary permissions and obtaining quotes.
- 3.2** Footpaths – it has been noted that some work has been undertaken by the North Yorkshire Highways in a bid to clean and tidy up the footpaths on Stockton Road in and out of the village. Further cleaning could be done
- 3.3** Queens Green Canopy - As part of the Queens jubilee – there is the opportunity for the village to plant a tree in a communal area. The village green would be a suitable location it was agreed. An application will be made to apply for a tree, and permission from the landowner will be sought.
